Biographical Note

Born in Cochabamba, Bolivia 1947, died in Cochabamba 2007; started to study architecture in a time when students were inspired by the Cuban Revolution and Che Guevara; fled from the Bolivian and more general the Latin American dictatorships of that time to Europe around 1970 and settled temporarily in the Netherlands; started to study urban planning and realized the more permanent character of her stay in the Netherlands; found a job working for the province South-Holland and studied for instance the history of planning in the first decades of the twentieth century and the different appreciation by men and women of public space planning; visited many times her family and friends in Bolivia; died in Cochabamba on 9th March 2007.
